* Conditions: Only members of the AACBT(WA) are eligible to borrow from the library. The borrowing procedure involves completing a Library Request Form and sending it to the above address. To assist with faster processing please also email your request to: Talia Hayman aacbtwa@gmail.com. The form will ask for credit card details as a measure of security against lost or damaged items. Requests from members will be sent to the borrower's home address via post, at the expense of the AACBT. Borrowed items will need to be returned to the AACBT, at the borrower's expense.

The borrowing limit is two weeks for metropolitan members and four weeks for rural members. If an item is not returned within the borrowing period, the borrower will be contacted by telephone or email. If the item is not returned before a six-week period, the item will be considered lost and the cost of replacing the item will be charged to the borrower's credit card. Items are subject to availability.

Only members of the AACBT are eligible to borrow from the library. Items are to be viewed in a private setting and only by AACBT members. AACBT reserves the right to revoke future library borrowing rights if these conditions are not upheld by members.
