SPEECH FORMAT IDEAS 1 (Optional)

1. Bride's Father or Representative:

3. Toast of thanks to Bridesmaids. BESTMAN:
4. Response by GROOM (presentations?):
5. Reading of Emails/Faxes GROOMSMEN:
6. Propose Toast to Absent Friends:

Note that the order of 3 and 4 can be alternated
(I believe the format shown works best however)

SPEECH FORMAT IDEAS 2 (Optional)

1. Toast to the Bride & Bridegroom - Usually proposed by someone who has known one or both of the bridal couple for some time
2. Response and toast of thanks to the bridesmaids (GROOM)
3. Response on behalf of bridesmaids (BESTMAN)
4. Toast to Brides Parents - Usually a close family friend or relative.
5. Response by BRIDES FATHER or representative
6. Toast to Bridegrooms Parents - Usually a close family friend or relative.
7. Response by BRIDEGROOMS FATHER or representative
8. Reading of telegrams Groomsmen
9. Toast to absent friends
