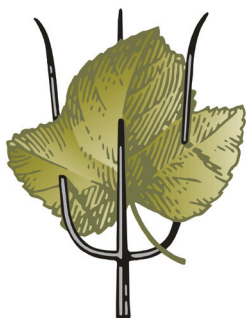

RESULTS FOR HAY SHED HILL WINES



2010 HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 1 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC

This is an outstanding example of Margaret River blended white. The use of a small amount of oak has augmented with tightly wound fruit and created a lean and angular palate of great penetration. Very complex with the potential to develop with extended cellaring.

Score: **93/100** Cellaring: 9 years.



2010 HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 6 CHARDONNAY

This is a single vineyard chardonnay from Hay Shed. Has a spicy minerally and subtle grapefruit character on the nose. It's a very fine and almost delicate chardonnay yet there is admirable power that targets a precise long finish. A very expressive and interesting wine.

Score: **94/100** Cellaring: 7 years.



2009 HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 2 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This is sourced from some of the oldest vines in Margaret River. I believe this is the best cabernet Kerrigan has made from Hay Shed Hill. So elegant and stylish yet at the same time has the power and intensity that is evident in Margaret River. Wonderful balance of oak, tannins and fruit. A wine for extended cellaring.

Score: **95/100** Cellaring: 10 years.



2011 HAY SHED HILL SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON

Bursts out of the blocks with a crunchy lively fresh tropical character. Lots of herbs and gooseberry with a generous splash of lime juice. Passionfruit sweetness on the palate contributes to its bright fresh lines. So good as a current drink.

Score: **90/100** Cellaring: 3 years.
