Interventions to promote breastfeeding

This review assessed the effectiveness of health care system interventions aimed at promoting and supporting breastfeeding. In terms of the timing of interventions, prenatal interventions were more effective than usual care in increasing the rate of short-term (1-3 months) breastfeeding. Combined pre- and postnatal interventions improved the rates of intermediate (4-5 months) and long-term (6-8 months) feeding compared with usual care. In terms of intervention type, education increased the rate of breastfeeding initiation; individual level professional support increased the rate of intermediate breastfeeding; and peer support increased the rate of both short- and long-term breastfeeding.
