Australian National 24-hour breastfeeding helpline

The Federal Minister for Health and Ageing, Nicola Roxon, recently launched a national toll-free 24-hour helpline to provide support with breastfeeding information. The Commonwealth Government has provided \$2.5 million to help establish and run the service, as well as a further \$1.8 million to help train breastfeeding counsellors. The helpline - 1800 MUM 2 MUM - is staffed by volunteers for the Australian Breastfeeding Association (<http://www.breastfeeding.asn.au/>)
