Wine Style Light bodied white wine.
Grape Variety Sauvignon Blanc.
Growing Region Frankland River, Western Australia.
Technical Details Alc. 13.5% ph 3.31 TA 6.1g/L RS 0.18g/L
Appearance Pale green.
Nose Compelling and lively aromas of tropical passionfruit, gooseberry and lime zest.
Palate Intense and fresh tropical notes of passionfruit, mango, paw paw and zesty citrus with clean acidity and a textured finish.
Vinification 2008 season benefited greatly from 40mm of rain the week prior to Christmas 2007. The rain filled the soil profiles with water, not only encouraging growth of full canopies to protect the fruit in the hotter summer days, but also keeping Sauvignon Blanc fruit fresh, clean and juicy! Ferngrove harvest Sauvignon Blanc after midnight when the temperature drops and then crush and press quickly prior to a cool fermentation. Several yeasts are used to enhance the different characters of individual blocks.
Cellaring This wine is best enjoyed now but will cellar up to two years.
Winemaker's Comments Fresh and zippy, the Sauvignon Blanc has the distinctive varietal characters of the region.
Food Enjoy with grilled barramundi and mango salsa.
Serve Slightly chilled – 8-12°C.
