The ALKOOMI vineyards and winery are located in the Frankland River district of Western Australia's Great Southern wine region. Since climatic conditions are similar to those of Bordeaux in France, it is not surprising that this region produces some of the best wines made in Australia. The name ALKOOMI is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose'. The logo represents a distinctive Australian plant which grows in the area

2010 Sauvignon Blanc

This excellent wine is made from carefully selected grapes grown in the Alkoomi estate vineyards located in the Frankland River region of Western Australian



Vintage: A warm and sunny start to the 2010 vintage led to early flavour development at lower sugar levels, producing wines of great flavour while retaining delicacy and finesse.

Colour: Pale straw with a vibrant green tinge at the rim.

Bouquet: Grassy aromas of sugar snap peas and gooseberries.

Palate: Clean, soft and fresh with a mid-palate of citrus fruits and a textured persistent finish.

Cellaring: Most attractive when young, but will develop in the short term.

Alcohol: 12.0% **pH:** 3.23
