Vintage

The 2014 growing season in the south west of Western Australia was again favourable for the production of great wine, both red & white. Ample winter and spring rains filled the soil profiles. The ripening period proved to be close to idyllic with little rain and relatively mild temperatures enabling grapes to be harvested at optimum sugar and acid levels.

Winemaking

Night harvest at low temperatures, immediate processing at the winery, gentle handling, and cool fermentation all contribute to the retained fruit freshness and varietal aromatics. A small component fermented in older oak textures the palate.

Tasting Notes

Clear pale straw in colour. Alluring aromas of guava, pear, lemon zest and hints of jasmine greet the nose. The palate shows apple, pear and passionfruit notes around a key lime citrus background. A bright, juicy wine with bags of fruit and a zesty acidity that provides ample length.

Food Matching

Pork and shiitake mushroom San choi bao, a goats cheese tart, or lemon chicken and prawn skewers from the BBQ.

Cellaring

The abundant fruit flavours and vibrant structure make this wine a delicious drink when young.
