The pride and joy of the Singlefile Estate vintage is the 2008 Reserve Chardonnay (RRP \$45). Using the very best quality of the fruit grown on the estate, this elegant



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chardonnay is crisp and refreshing with a subtle oak finish. Winemaker Coby Ladwig describes the wine as 'distinctive' and 'elegant,' stating "Although we take great pride in all of our wines, if we were to develop a reputation based on one vintage only, it would be the Reserve."

For the red-drinkers, Singlefile Estate 2007 Shiraz (RRP \$33) is superb. Upon tasting, the wine provides fragrant aromas of fresh berry, spice and chocolate with a hint of smoky oak. This deep-magenta red wine is currently the sole offering from Singlefile Estate in the red wine market, however if the shiraz is anything to go by, exciting times are ahead as the winery adds new varieties to their repertoire.

The 2008 Semillon Sauvignon Blanc (RRP \$24) is sure to excite loyal SSB drinkers. This wine is highly aromatic – displaying guava, green beans and herbal notes. Hints of citrus and grassy characters are also evident. Most importantly, the palate has a refreshing acidity and a zesty, mineral texture – perfect for a summer's day.

Continuing with the high quality white wines, the 2008 Unwooded Chardonnay (RRP \$22) is a perfect accompaniment to a social meal with friends. The palate is rich and surprisingly mouth-filling with a freshness and vibrancy displaying stone fruits, melons and tropical notes.

Lastly, Singlefile Estate offers a rosé to meet demand for the ever-increasing popularity of rosé in Australia. The 2008 Rosé (RRP \$18) is a blend of cabernet sauvignon and shiraz, providing excellent fruit sweetness combined with a lasting crisp finish. This is a great wine for leisurely barbecues, or to enjoy with your favourite curry.
