## Putty/Waxes

**Modeling Putty/Wax™** & **Modeling Wax** are products that can be used to build up areas like the chin, cheek or nose. Scars and cuts can also be made with these products.



- **Modeling Putty/Wax™** is the stiffest wax and can be softened by kneading or rolling in the palm of the hands. **Spirit Gum** should be applied to the skin surface to provide a sticky surface to adhere the **Modeling Putty/Wax™**.
- **Modeling Wax** is a soft, supple wax that is easy to blend and is flexible on moving parts of the body. It's good for smoothing the edges on prosthetic pieces, building up facial areas and blocking out eyebrows.

To help smooth or blend the edges on either of these products, use a little **Makeup Remover**.

After you have blended the edges and formed the desired shape, the waxes should be sealed with a coat of **Fixative "A"™** to provide a protective coating which will remove tackiness and allow makeup to be applied.

Remember, waxes will always be soft under the makeup and will be subject to dents if hit.

To remove wax products, gently peel off and remove any stickiness with **Spirit Gum Remover**.
